


East Palo Alto Data Sheet

There are 3,436 students enrolled in 9 schools in East Palo Alto.*


The vast majority of those (80%) are Latino, 91% are lowincome, 54% are English Learners, and 14% are students with disabilities.

*For the purposes of this data sheet, East Palo Alto refers to any school (district and charter) operated by Ravenswood City School District.

Percent of Students on Grade Level in math, 2014-15 to present

Results are low for all students across the district. In 2018-19 less than 2 in 10 students are on grade level in English and math. These trends have been consistent for the last five years.
